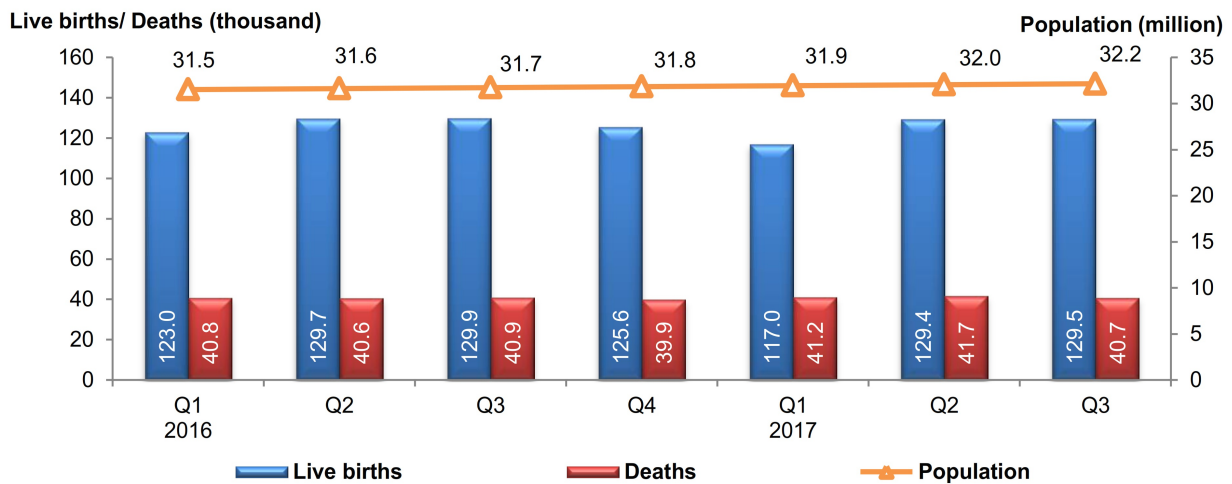

[Chart 1] Demographic statistics third quarter (Q3) 2017, Malaysia



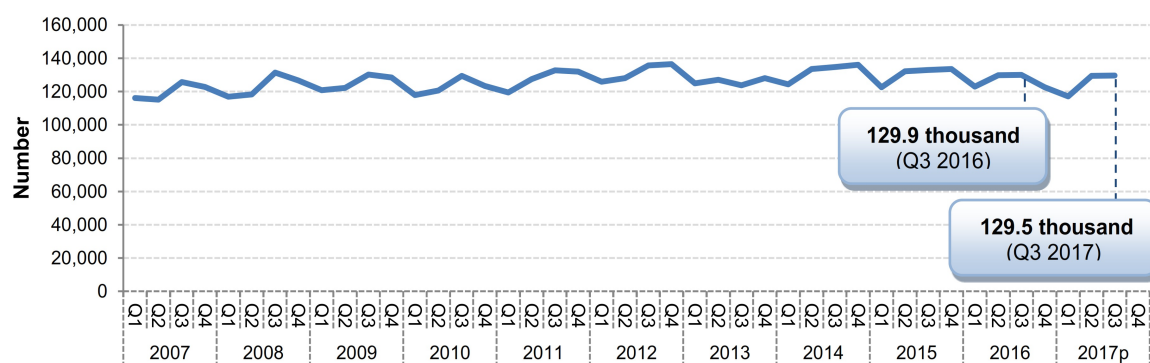

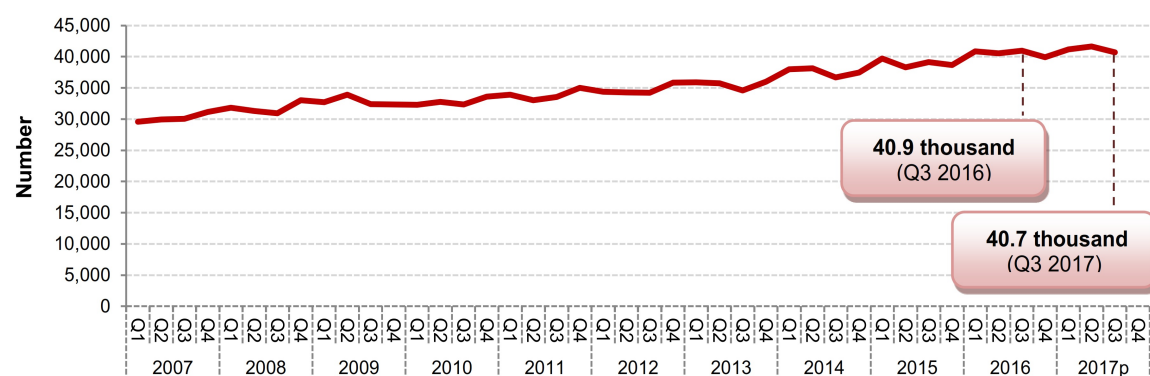
