MONTHLY RUBBER STATISTICS MALAYSIA, SEPTEMBER 2017

Production of natural rubber (NR) dropped 14.1 per cent in September 2017

Natural rubber (NR) production dropped by **14.1** per cent in September 2017 to **52,472** tonnes compared to August 2017. Smallholding sector is the main contributor of NR production which is more than **90** per cent.

Average monthly price of latex concentrate and S.M.R.20 in September 2017 at **552.31** sen per kilogramme and **660.50** sen per kilogramme respectively. The average monthly price of latex concentrate increased by **8.79** sen per kilogramme (**1.6%**) from August 2017. Meanwhile, the average monthly price of S.M.R.20 increased by **16.25** sen per kilogramme (**2.5%**).

Exports of NR in September 2017 recorded at **45,144** tonnes, decreased by **18.3** per cent than the previous month. Five main destinations of NR exports were China, Germany, Iran, Finland and U.S.A.

Meanwhile, domestic consumption of NR in September 2017 decreased by **3.6** per cent to **40,254** tonnes from previous month **73.5** per cent of domestic consumption dominated by the rubber glove industry.

The level of NR stocks went up by **0.3** per cent to **194,095** tonnes at the end of September 2017.

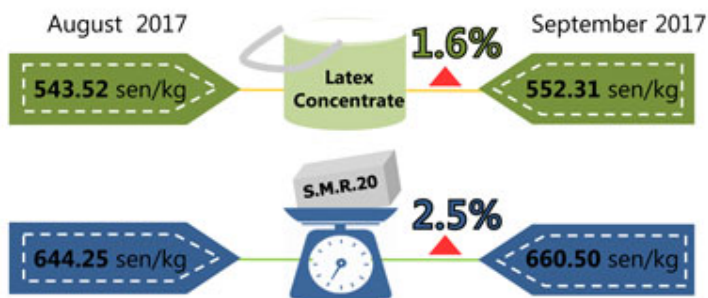


Production of natural rubber (NR) dropped 14.1 per cent in September 2017

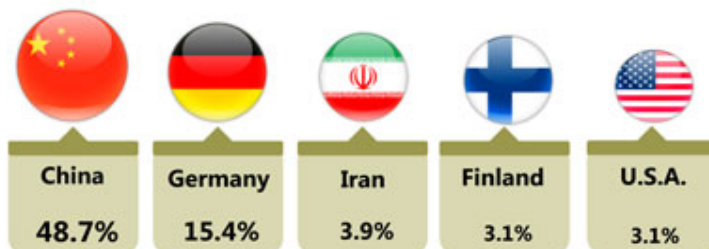

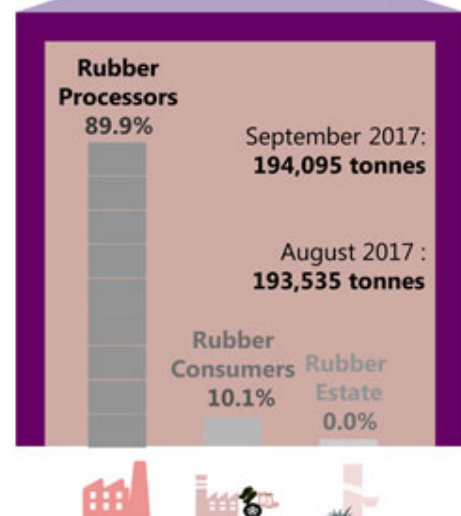
Exports

Exports of natural rubber decreased by 18.3% as compared to August 2017. The main destination of NR exports was China.

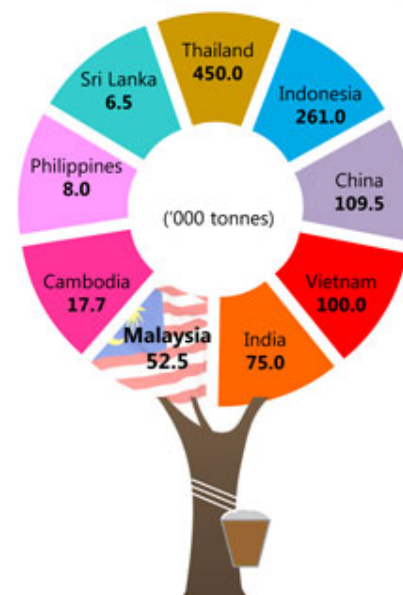

Production of Natural Rubber by Association of Natural Rubber Producing Countries (ANRPC)



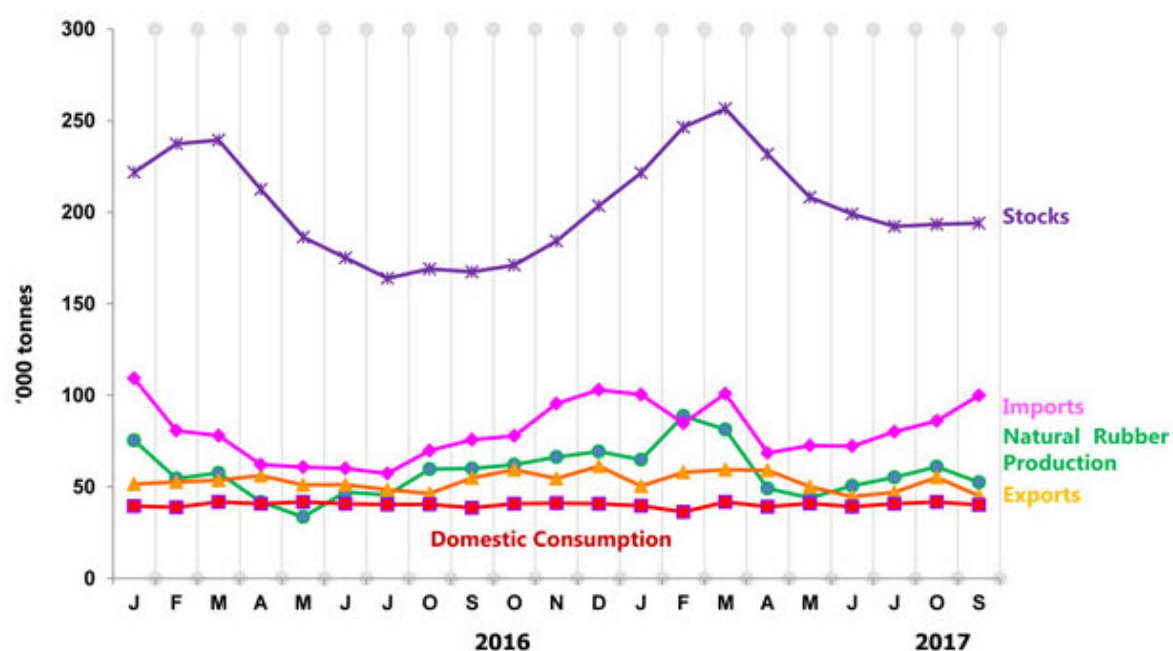
